

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows :—

3 On and after First day of July, One thousand nine hundred and nineteen, there shall be annually paid and applied out of the Consolidated Revenue to the respective persons holding the offices named in the Schedule to this Act the respective sums set opposite the names of such offices in the said schedule.
