AN ACT to amend the Laws relating to the Ports of this Colony. [28 April, 1857.]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows :-

1 All sums payable under the "Port Act, 1854," in respect of Appropriation of services performed by any Harbour Master shall be paid by the Port fees for services Officer receiving the same to the Colonial Treasurer, and shall form performed by Harbour Masters. part of the General Revenue.

2 So much of the Act of Council of the 2nd Victoria, No. 5, Repeal of so much intituled An Act to consolidate and amend the Laws for the Preserva- of 2 Vict. No. 5 tion of the Ports and the Regulation of Shipping within the same, as as remains in force. now remains in force is hereby repealed, excepting always as to all or any offences committed, or acts, matters, or things done, before this Act takes effect, which shall be dealt with as if this Act had not been passed.

3 Section 1 of this Act and the " Port Act, 1854," shall be read and This Act to be construed together as one Act.

- 4 In referring to this Act it shall be sufficient to use the expression Short Title. " The Port Act, 1857."
 - 5 This Act shall come into operation on the first day of May, 1857.
