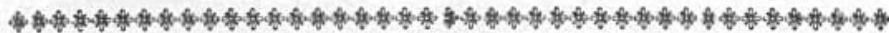

AN ACT to amend the Laws relating to the  
Ports of this Colony. [28 April, 1857.]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the the Governor of *Tasmania*, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows :—

**1** All sums payable under the "*Port Act, 1854*," in respect of services performed by any Harbour Master shall be paid by the Port Officer receiving the same to the Colonial Treasurer, and shall form part of the General Revenue. Appropriation of fees for services performed by Harbour Masters.

**2** So much of the Act of Council of the 2nd *Victoria*, No. 5, intituled *An Act to consolidate and amend the Laws for the Preservation of the Ports and the Regulation of Shipping within the same*, as now remains in force is hereby repealed, excepting always as to all or any offences committed, or acts, matters, or things done, before this Act takes effect, which shall be dealt with as if this Act had not been passed. Repeal of so much of 2 Vict. No. 5 as remains in force.

**3** Section 1 of this Act and the "*Port Act, 1854*," shall be read and construed together as one Act. This Act to be read with the *Port Act, 1854*.

**4** In referring to this Act it shall be sufficient to use the expression "*The Port Act, 1857*." Short Title.

**5** This Act shall come into operation on the first day of *May*, 1857.
