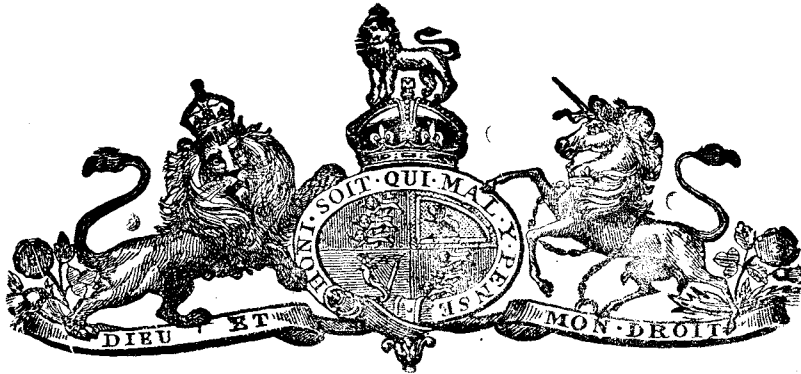

AN ACT to amend "The Pawnbrokers Act."

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows :—

1 This Act may be cited as "The Pawnbrokers Act, 1924."

Short title.

2 Section Six of "The Pawnbrokers Act" is hereby repealed and the following section substituted therefor :—

Repeal of Section Six of "The Pawnbrokers Act" (21 Vict. No. 23), and substitution of new section.

"**6**—(1) Any person desiring to take out a licence as a pawnbroker shall lodge with the clerk of the court of petty sessions nearest to the place at which his shop is situate, a notice of his intention to apply for such licence to two justices at such court on a date to be fixed by the clerk, being not less than ten days after the lodging of such notice.

Application for licence to be made to justices in petty sessions.

(2) On the day so fixed the justices shall hear the application, and, if they are of opinion that the applicant is deserving of such licence, and that his shop is suitable for the business, they shall deliver to the applicant a certificate under their hands approving of his receiving such licence, and specifying the shop in which the business is to be carried on."
