

2. Repeal of Section Six of "The Pawnbrokers Act" (21 Vict. No. 23), and substitution of new section. Application for licence to be made to justices in petty sessions.

******* AN ACT to amend "The Pawnbrokers Act." $\lceil 6 \ December, \ 1924. \rceil$

Short title.

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

1 This Act may be cited as "The Pawnbrokers Act, 1924."

2 Section Six of "The Pawnbrokers Act" is hereby repealed and the Repeal of Section following section substituted therefor: -

" $\mathbf{6}$ —(1) Any person desiring to take out a licence as a pawnbroker "6—(1) Any person desiring to take out a licence as a pawnbroker Act" (21 Vict. shall lodge with the clerk of the court of petty sessions nearest to the No. 23), and place at which his shop is situate, a notice of his intention to apply for substitution of such licence to two justices at such court on a date to be fixed by the clerk, being not less than ten days after the lodging of such notice.

(2) On the day so fixed the justices shall hear the application, and, if they are of opinion that the applicant is deserving of such licence, and sessions. that his shop is suitable for the business, they shall deliver to the applicant a certificate under their hands approving of his receiving such licence, and specifying the shop in which the business is to be carried on."
