AN ACT to provide for the Erection and Construction of certain Public Buildings. A.D. 1884.

[24 November, 1884.]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of *Tasmania*, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

1 It shall be lawful for the Minister of Lands and Works to cause the several Works mentioned in the Schedule to be erected, constructed, and completed, at a cost for each separate Work not exceeding the amount therein set opposite such Work. Minister of Lands to cause Works to be constructed.

2 The cost of such Works shall be defrayed out of the moneys provided by Parliament for that purpose. Defrayment of cost of Works.

3 The Governor in Council may, upon the recommendation of the Minister, out of the moneys hereby appropriated, authorise the Minister to purchase, acquire, and take any land, with or without buildings thereon, which he deems suitable for the purposes of any Work by this Act authorised. Purchase, &c. of land.

4 This Act may be cited as "The Public Buildings Erection Act, 1884." Short title.
