

AN ACT to provide for the Erection of A.D. 1889. certain Public Buildings.

[5 December, 1889.]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

1 In this Act, unless the context otherwise determines—

Interpretation.

- "The Minister" means the Minister of Lands and Works for the time being, and includes any person appointed by him or acting under his order.
- 2 It shall be lawful for the Minister to cause the several Works Minister to cause mentioned in the Schedule to be erected, constructed, and completed, at Works to be cona cost for each separate Work not exceeding the amount therein set structed. opposite such Work.

- 3 The cost of the several Works specified in the Schedule shall be Defrayment of defrayed out of the moneys to be provided by Parliament for that cost of Works. purpose.
- 4 The Governor in Council may, upon the recommendation of the Purchase, &c. of Minister, out of the moneys hereby appropriated, authorise the Minister land. to purchase, acquire, and take any land, with or without buildings thereon, which he deems suitable for the purposes of any Work by this Act authorised.

Public Buildings Erection.

Appropriation of money voted by 49 Vict. No. 42.

5 The sum of Five thousand Pounds appropriated by "The Public Works Construction Act, 1885," for and towards the erection of "Offices for Analyst and Government Statistician" shall and may be applied for and towards the erection of a Technical School and Offices for Analyst at *Hobart*.

Appropriation of money voted by 49 Vict. No. 46.

6 Any portion of the sum of Three thousand Pounds appropriated by "The Public Buildings Erection Act, 1885," for and towards the construction and erection of "Additions to Museum, and to provide an Art Gallery, *Hobart*," shall and may be applied for and towards the construction and erection of fittings for such buildings.

Appropriation for Industrial School, Launceston, conditional. 7 The sum of One thousand Pounds hereby appropriated in aid of the building erected for use as an Industrial School, Launceston, shall be paid only upon such conditions as the Minister shall prescribe to prevent any money being borrowed upon the security of the said building.

Short title.

8 This Act may be cited as "The Public Buildings Erection Act, 1889."
