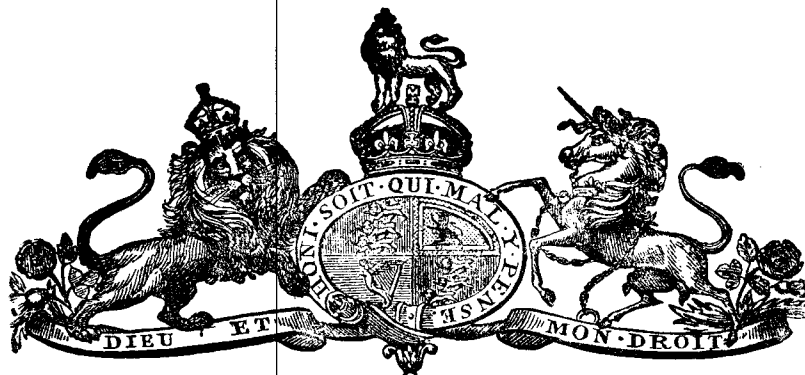

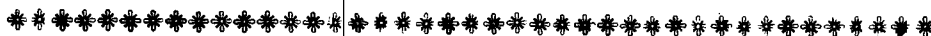

AN ACT to amend "The Potato Diseases Act, 1909." A.D. 1910.
[30 September, 1910.]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of *Tasmania*, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

1 This Act may be cited as "The Potato Diseases Amendment Act, 1910," and shall be incorporated and read as one with "The Potato Diseases Act, 1909" (in this Act referred to as the Principal Act), and its amendments. Short title and incorporation with 9 Ed. VII. No. 5.

Repeal of Section
11 of Principal
Act and substitu-
tion of new

2 Section Eleven of the Principal Act is hereby repealed, and the following section is substituted therefor:—

“**11** For the purposes of this Act a rate or contribution of not more than Two Shillings per acre may be fixed pursuant to Section Thirteen of this Act whenever in any year the Minister deems it necessary, and such rate or contribution shall be payable and paid in respect of all potato land by every occupier of potato land.”

Amendments to
Principal Act.

3 The Principal Act is hereby amended—

- i. As to Section Twelve, by omitting the word “annual :”
- ii. As to Section Thirteen, by omitting the word “annually :”
- iii. As to Section Fourteen, by omitting the words “Section Sixteen,” and substituting therefor the words “Section Seventeen.”

Impersonating
inspector a
misdemeanor.

4 Any person who shall falsely represent himself to be or shall personate an inspector or a person authorised by an inspector under the Principal Act, in any manner whatsoever, shall be guilty of a misdemeanor, and shall on conviction be liable to be imprisoned for any term not exceeding Twelve months, and shall in addition to such imprisonment be liable to forfeit and pay a penalty not exceeding One hundred Pounds.
