AN ACT to amend "The Public Health Act, 1907. [5 December, 1907.]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of *Tasmania*, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

1 This Act may be cited as "The Public Health Amendment Act, Short title. 1907," and shall be construed as one with "The Public Health Act, Incorporation. 1903," in this Act referred to as "the Principal Act." 3 Ed. VII. No. 37. 4d.]

Repeal of Section 173 of Principal Act and substitution of new section. Procedure. 19 Vict. No. 8. 2 Section One hundred and seventy-three of the Principal Act is hereby repealed, and the following substituted therefor:—

"173 All offences against the provisions of this Act or the regulations or by-laws, and all penalties, forfeitures, costs, sums of money, and expenses under the provisions of this Act or the regulations or by-laws, may, unless otherwise provided, be prosecuted and recovered by complaint in a summary way by and before a police magistrate or any Two or more justices, in the mode prescribe! by The Magistrates Summary Procedure Act."
