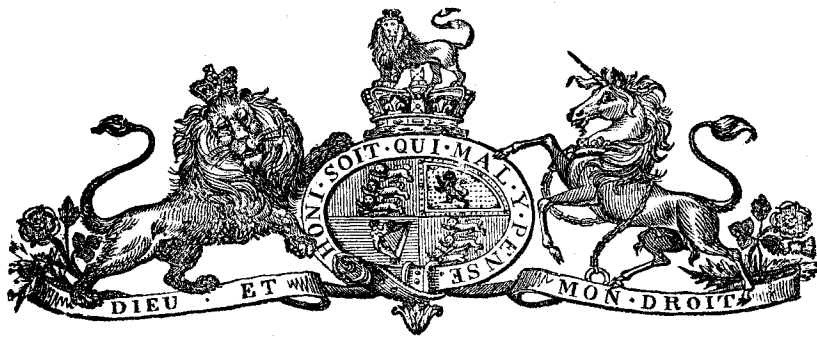

AN ACT to further amend "The Post Office Act, 1853." [11 October, 1867.]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of *Tasmania*, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows :—

1 A Receipt for *Rural Police Rate* by any Collector shall be received at any Post Office, and conveyed and delivered free of postage, provided that there be endorsed thereon or upon the cover of the same the words "Receipt for Rural Police Rate" and the signature of such Collector, anything in any other Act to the contrary notwithstanding. Receipts for Rural Police Rate free.

2 Section Thirty-six of "The Post Office Act, 1853," is hereby repealed. Repeal.

3 This Act and "The Post Office Act, 1853," save as altered or repealed by this Act, shall be deemed one Act. Acts to be deemed one.

4 This Act may be cited as "The Post Office Act, 1867." Short title.
