

#### ANALYSIS.

1. Short title and incorporation with 63 Vict. No. 51.

2. After 1st January, 1911, rate at which expenses of members to be reimbursed increased to £150 per annum.

3. Payment to Premier without office.

AN ACT to "The Payment of 1910. amend Members Act, 1900." [30] December, 1910.]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:

1-(1.) This Act may be cited as "The Payment of Members Short title and Act, 1910," and shall be incorporated and read as one with "The incorporation Payment of Members Act, 1900," hereinafter referred to as "the with 63 Vict.

(2.) This Act shall come into force on the First day of January, One thousand nine hundred and eleven, and take effect as from that date.

### Payment of Members.

#### A.D. 1910.

After 1st January, 1911, rate at which expenses of members to be reimbursed increased to £150 per annum.

2 From and after the First day of January, One thousand nine hundred and eleven, the rate at which every member shall be entitled to receive reimbursement of his expenses out of the Consolidated Revenue, pursuant to the Principal Act, shall be at the rate of One hundred and fifty Pounds per annum, in lieu of the rate of One hundred Pounds per annum as provided by Subsection (1.) of Section Four of the Principal Act.

Payment to Premier without office.

3 Section Six of the Principal Act shall not apply to any person holding the position of Premier without Ministerial office.
