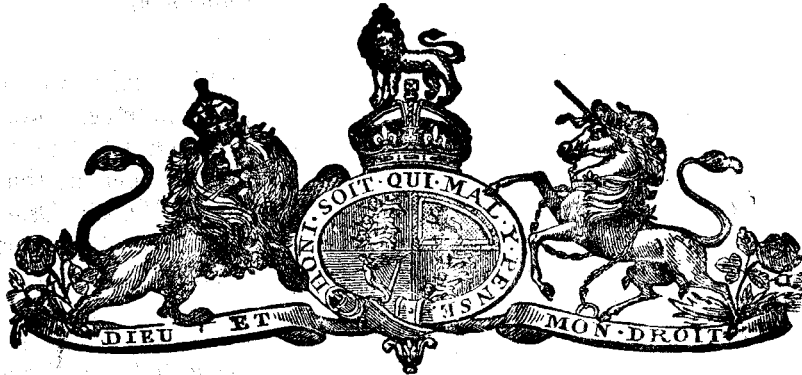

AN ACT to extend the Time for Payment of ^{A.D.} 1914.
 Rents in respect of Leases and Licences
 issued under "The Mining Act, 1905," or
 any former Mining Act, and for other pur-
 poses. [26 November, 1914.]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and
 with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of
 Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

Payment of Mining Rents Postponement.

Postponement of
due date of
mining rents.

2—(1) The time for any payment of rent which fell due on the First day of July, One thousand nine hundred and fourteen, under or in respect of any subsisting lease or licence issued under "The Mining Act, 1905," or any former Mining Act, is hereby postponed, so that such payment shall fall due upon the Thirty-first day of March, One thousand nine hundred and fifteen, and not earlier, or upon the expiration of such (if any) further period or periods of postponement as is, or are, specified by proclamation.

(2) The Governor may, by proclamation, from time to time prolong or further prolong the period of postponement provided by Subsection 1 of this Section for the period of time specified in such proclamation, provided that no such period so specified shall expire later than the Thirtieth day of June, One thousand nine hundred and fifteen.
