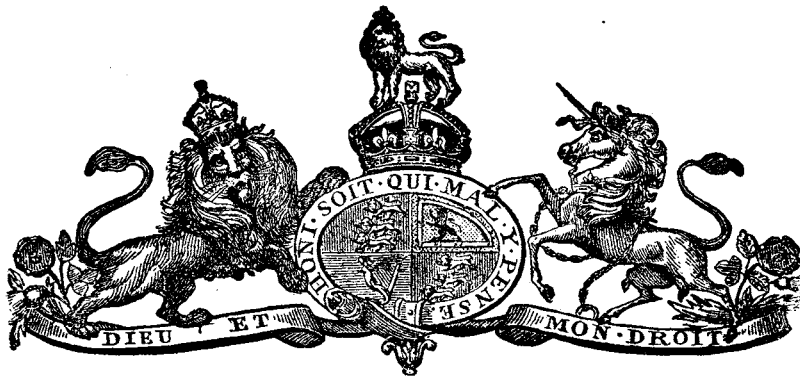

AN ACT to amend "The Parliamentary Privilege Act, 1898." [11 November, 1904.] A.D. 1904. —

WHEREAS it is desirable to amend "The Parliamentary Privilege Act, 1898 :"
PREAMBLE.
62 Vict. No. 30.

Be it therefore enacted by His Excellency the Governor of *Tasmania*, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows :—

1 The authority of the President or Speaker mentioned in Section Five of the said Act, shall, anything contained in the Audit Act to the contrary notwithstanding, be deemed to have been, and shall be sufficient to enable the Auditor-General to grant a full and complete discharge in respect of any expenditure so authorised : Provided that any such expenditure may be disallowed by either House of Parliament. Authority of President or Speaker to be final.

2 This Act, and "The Parliamentary Privilege Act," and "The Parliamentary Privilege Act Amendment Act, 1885," and "The Parliamentary Privilege Act, 1898," shall be read and construed together as one Act. Acts to be read together.

3 This Act may be cited as "The Parliamentary Privilege Act, 1904." Short title.
