AN ACT to amend "The Police Rate Act, A.D. 1899. 1898." [1 December, 1899.]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows :----

1 This Act may be cited as "The Police Rate Act, 1899."

2 In this Act the expression "the said Act" shall mean "The Interpretation. 62 Vict. No. 49. Police Rate Act, 1898."

3-(1.) The words "the Governor in Council may make and levy" in the Second and Third lines of Section Three of the said Act are Section Three of hereby expunged, and the words "there shall be charged, levied, and 62 Vict. No. 49. paid" are inserted in lieu thereof; and the said Section shall be construed as if the words hereby inserted had been from the date of the passing of the said Act inserted in the said Section in lieu of the words

hereby expunged. (2.) The words "and Police" are hereby inserted after the word "Municipal" in the Eighth line of Section Three of the said Act, and shall be deemed to have been so inserted as from the date of the passing of the said Act.

4 All rates purporting to have been demanded, collected, received, or paid in and for the year 1899 under the said Act, shall be deemed to have been duly demanded, collected, received, or paid, and all persons are hereby freed and discharged from all actions, suits, damages, liabilities, and charges whatever to which they or any of them might otherwise be liable for having at any time demanded, levied, collected, or received any rate or sum of money purporting to be a rate under the said Act.

5 This Act and the said Act save as hereby amended, shall be read and construed together as one and the same Act.
