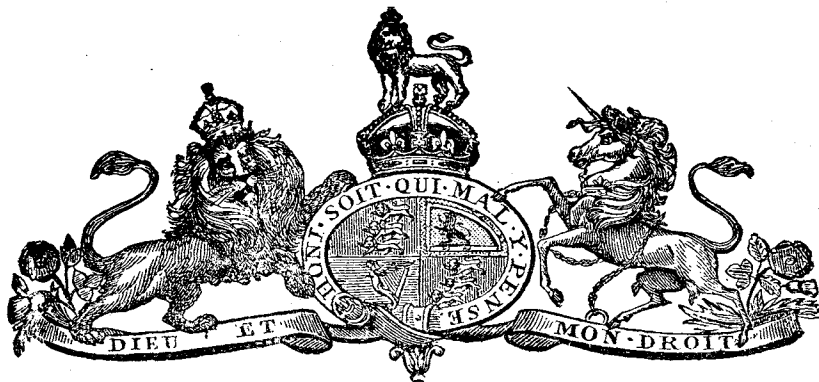

AN ACT to provide for the Appointment as ^{A.D.} **1907.**
 Permanent Officers of the Public Service
 of persons temporarily employed therein
 at the commencement of "The Public
 Service Act, 1905," and to amend that Act.

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of *Tasmania*, by and
 with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of
 Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows :—

1 This Act may be cited as "The Public Service Amendment Act, 1907," and shall be read and construed with "The Public Service Act, 1905."

Public Service Amendment.

2 Notwithstanding the provisions of "The Public Service Act, 1905," if any Responsible Minister of the Crown certifies in writing under his hand to the Board that any person temporarily employed at the commencement of "The Public Service Act, 1905," in any office or department of the Public Service under or controlled by such Minister, in his opinion ought to be appointed as a permanent officer, the Governor, on the recommendation of the Board, may appoint such person as a permanent officer as from the date of the commencement of the temporary employment, or as from a date subsequent thereto.
