

AN ACT to provide for the Erection of certain A.D. 1882. Public Schools. [9 October, 1882.]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

It shall be lawful for the Governor in Council, upon the recommendation of the Board of Education, to cause School Houses to be cause School Houses to be erected and built or added to or improved in such of the localities mentioned in the Schedule as the Board may from time to time determine, the whole the sum of Twenty thousand Pounds. at a cost not exceeding in the whole the sum of Twenty thousand Pounds.

- 2 "The Public Schools Erection Act, 1880," and every amendment Acts to be read thereof, and this Act, shall be read and construed together as one Act.
- 3 This Act may be cited as "The Public Schools Erection Short title. Act, 1883."
