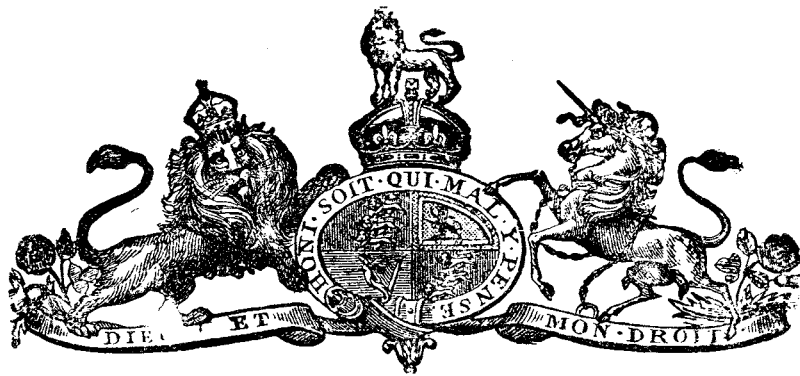

AN ACT to amend the Public Servants' Retiring and Death Allowances Act, 1925.

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows :—

2 Section Three of the Public Servants' Retiring and Death Allowances Act, 1925, is hereby amended as follows :—

1. By inserting “(1)” before the word “There” at the commencement of that section : and
11. By inserting the following new Subsection (2) after Subsection (1) thereof :—

“(2) Subsection (1) of this section, in so far as the same relates to the voluntary retirement of public servants who have reached the age of sixty years, shall, for the purposes of its application in connection with Section Eighty-four of the Commonwealth of Australia Constitution Act, but for that purpose only, be deemed to have been in operation at the establishment of the Commonwealth: Provided, however, that this subsection shall not apply to or in respect of any officer of the Commonwealth Public Service who retired from such service prior to the first day of January, one thousand nine hundred and twenty-seven”
