AN ACT to amend the articles of association of the Tasmanian Pensioners Union with respect to the quorum for a general meeting, and for related purposes.

[Royal Assent 17 April 1986]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

1—This Act may be cited as the *Tasmanian Pensioners Union (Articles of Association) Act 1986*. Short title.

2—This Act shall commence on the day on which it receives the Royal assent. Commence-
ment.

Interpretation.

3—In this Act, “the company” means the company limited by guarantee incorporated in Tasmania under the name Tasmanian Pensioners Union.

Amendment of articles of association.

4—(1) The articles of association of the company are amended as follows:—

(a) by omitting from paragraph (ii) of article 20 “A quorum of the Union, State Conference, State Council, Regional Council” and substituting “A quorum of the State Conference, the State Council, or a Regional Council”;

(b) by omitting from paragraph (ii) of article 20 “the business of the Union or” and substituting “the business”;

(c) by adding at the end of article 20 the following paragraph:—

(iii) Twenty-five members personally present (being members entitled under these rules to vote thereat) constitute a quorum for the transaction of the business of a general meeting of the Union.

(2) Nothing in this Act prevents the amendment, by any other-wise lawful means, of the articles of association of the company as amended by subsection (1).
