AN ACT to amend the articles of association of the Tasmanian Pensioners Union with respect to the quorum for a general meeting, and for related purposes.

[Royal Assent 17 April 1986]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

- 1—This Act may be cited as the Tasmanian Pensioners Union Short title. (Articles of Association) Act 1986.
- **2**—This Act shall commence on the day on which it receives the Commence-ment.

Interpretation.

3—In this Act, "the company" means the company limited by guarantee incorporated in Tasmania under the name Tasmanian Pensioners Union.

Amendment of articles of association.

- **4**—(1) The articles of association of the company are amended as follows:—
 - (a) by omitting from paragraph (ii) of article 20 "A quorum of the Union, State Conference, State Council, Regional Council" and substituting "A quorum of the State Conference, the State Council, or a Regional Council";
 - (b) by omitting from paragraph (ii) of article 20 "the business of the Union or" and substituting "the business";
 - (c) by adding at the end of article 20 the following paragraph:—
 - (iii) Twenty-five members personally present (being members entitled under these rules to vote thereat) constitute a quorum for the transaction of the business of a general meeting of the Union.
- (2) Nothing in this Act prevents the amendment, by any otherwise lawful means, of the articles of association of the company as amended by subsection (1).
