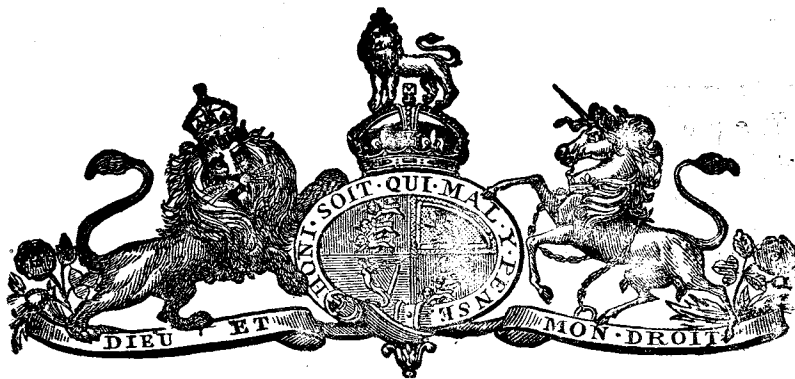

AN ACT to validate a certain Proclamation ^{A.D.} 1907.
 made on the First day of *November*, 1907.
 [5 *December*, 1907.]

WHEREAS it is desirable to validate a certain proclamation dated the First day of *November*, One thousand nine hundred and seven: PREAMBLE.

Be it therefore enacted by His Excellency the Governor of *Tasmania*, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

1 This Act may be cited as “The Proclamation Validation Act, 1907,” and shall be construed as one with “The Local Government Act, 1906.” Short title and incorporation with 6 Ed. VII. No. 31.

2 The proclamation dated the First, and gazetted the Fifth day of *November*, One thousand nine hundred and seven, and purporting to be made for the purpose of correcting an incorrect description of the boundaries of certain wards of *Kentish* Municipality, shall be, and be deemed to have been, as from the date thereof, a legal exercise of power, and valid and effectual according to the tenor thereof.
