#### AN ACT to further amend The Property [18 October, 1870.] Valuation Act.

W HEREAS it is necessary more distinctly to define the principles PREAMBLE. upon which the annual value of property should be ascertained: Be it therefore enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

- 1 Sections Two, Three, and Eight of "The Property Valuation Act, Repeal. No. 2," shall, except as to all things duly done thereunder, be repealed 32 Vict. No. 17. upon the commencement of this Act.
- 2 In every Assessment Roll which is hereafter made or revised in Rateable value accordance with any Law now or hereafter to be in force, the "rateable how ascertained. value" of any property shall be deemed and taken to be the annual rent which a tenant might reasonably be expected to pay for such property.
- 3 Every Assessment Roll hereafter made or revised shall be made out Form of Assessin the form in the Schedule.
- 4 Where the expression "the First day of November" occurs in the Section 24 of Twenty-fourth Section of The Property Valuation Act, the same shall 21 Vict. No. 19, be read and deemed to mean "the First day of September;" and where altered. the expression "the Thirty-first day of December" occurs in the said Section, the same shall be read and deemed to mean "the Thirty-first day of October."

## Property Valuation Act, No. 3.

Acts to be read together.

5 This Act, and The Property Valuation Act, and "The Property Valuation Act, No. 2," shall, save so far as the same may be altered or amended by this Act or either of the said Acts, be read and construed together as one and the same Act.

Short title.

6 This Act may be cited as "The Property Valuation Act, No. 3."
