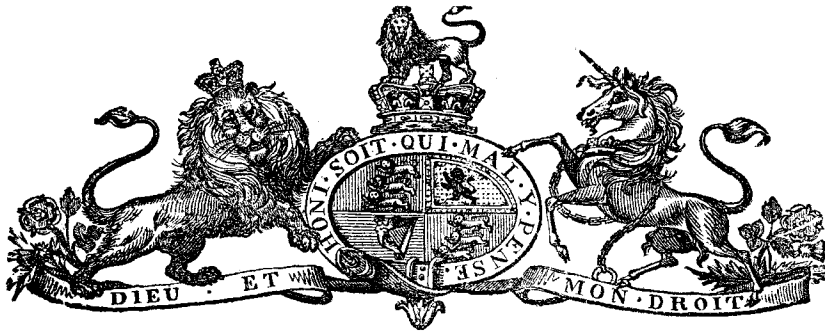

No. 22.

AN ACT to provide for the Construction of certain Public Works. [17 September, 1868.]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of *Tasmania*, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows :—

1 It shall be lawful for the Colonial Treasurer to cause to be constructed and completed the several Works mentioned in the Schedule, at a cost for each separate Work not exceeding the amount therein set opposite such Work. Colonial Treasurer to cause Works to be constructed.

2 The cost of such Works shall be defrayed out of the moneys to be raised by Loan for that purpose under the authority of “The Public Works Loans Act, 1868.” Defrayment of cost of Works.

3 This Act may be cited as “The Public Works Act, 1868.” Short title.
