AN ACT to provide for the Construction of certain Public Works. [22 October, 1869.]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of *Tasmania*, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

1 It shall be lawful for the Colonial Treasurer to cause to be con- Colonial Treasurer structed and completed the several Works mentioned in the Schedule (1), to cause Works to at a cost for each separate Work not exceeding the amount therein set be constructed. opposite such Work.

- 2 The cost of such Works shall be defrayed out of the moneys to be Defrayment of raised by Loan for that purpose under the authority of "The Loans cost of Works. Act, 1869."
- 3 Out of the sum of £3500, "for completion of the Road from Appropriation of Port Esperance to Southport," and out of the sum of £2000, for a moneys to Works "Road or Track from Franklin following a proposed line of Tramroad," in Schedule (2.). appropriated by the Act 31st Victoria, No. 23, there may be applied in the construction and completion of the Works mentioned in the Schedule (2) the sums set opposite the same respectively, anything in the said Act to the contrary notwithstanding.

4 This Act may be cited as "The Public Works Act, 1869, No. 2." Short title.
