

AN ACT to provide for the Execution of 1926. certain Public Works, and for other pur-[17 December, 1926.] poses.

TE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

- 1 This Act may be cited as "The Public Works (Federal Aid Short title. Roads) Execution Act, 1926."
 - 2—(1) In this Act, unless the context otherwise requires— "The said agreement" means the agreement dated the twentythird day of August, one thousand nine hundred and

twenty-six, made between the Commonwealth and the State, a draft of which is set out in the schedule to the Commonwealth and State Roads Agreement Act, 1926:

- "Board" means the Main Roads Maintenance Board constituted under the Main Roads Maintenance Act, 1926:
- "Federal aid road" means a road, the construction or reconstruction of which is to be carried out under and in accordance with the said agreement, and the expression includes any portion of a Federal aid road:
- "Main road of the State" means a road which is for the time being a main road of the State within the meaning of any Act providing for the proclamation or declaration of such main roads:
- "Municipality" means a municipality within the meaning of, or constituted or proclaimed under, the Local Government Act, 1906:
- "Schedule" means schedule to this Act:
- "The said works" means the works, objects, and purposes authorised to be constructed, executed, carried out, and completed under this Act.
- (2) A list of Federal aid roads is set out in the schedule.

Repeal of 17 Geo. V. No. 25.

Transfer of expenditure to account in respect of this Act.

3-(1) The Public Works Execution Act (No. 4), 1926 (hereinafter called "the repealed Act"), is hereby repealed.

(2) All expenditure incurred prior to the commencement of this Act, and which has been debited, or which, but for such repeal, would have been debited, to any account opened in the Treasury books in respect of the repealed Act, shall be transferred and debited to an account to be opened in the Treasury books in respect of this Act.

Minister may cause works specified in schedule to be carried out. 4—(1) It shall be lawful for the Minister to cause to be constructed, executed, carried out, and completed the works, objects, and purposes mentioned in the second column of the schedule and opposite to which are set forth in the third column of the schedule the respective amounts proposed to be expended thereon under this Act, at a cost for each separate work, object, or purpose not exceeding the amount set forth in the said third column of the schedule in respect thereof.

How works to be carried out.

(2) The said works shall be constructed, executed, carried out, and completed by the Board on benalf of the Minister, and in accordance with the provisions of the said agreement.

Application of provisions of 45 Vict No. 31.

5 The provisions of the Branch Roads Construction Act, 1881, shall extend and apply to the said works as fully in all respects as if the said provisions had been incorporated in this Act.

Land required may be acquired under 1 Geo. V. No. 11 or 58 Vict. No. 17. 6 Notwithstanding anything contained in this or any other Act, any land required for the purpose of any of the said works may, at the option of the Minister, be purchased, acquired, or taken under the Land Resumption Act, 1910, or under the Land Vesting Act, 1894,

and, in the event of such option being exercised in respect of the Land A.D. 1926. Resumption Act, 1910, the provisions of that Act shall accordingly apply, and be deemed to be incorporated with this Act, in lieu of the provisions of the Branch Roads Construction Act, 1881.

7—(1) The cost of the said works shall be defrayed as follows:—

Cost, how to be defrayed.

- I. As to the sum of One hundred thousand Pounds, part thereof, out of moneys to be provided by the Commonwealth under the said agreement:
- 11. As to the sum of Sixty-five thousand six hundred and twentyfive Pounds, other part the eof, out of the moneys provided by this Act: and
- 111. As to the sum of Nine thousand three hundred and seventyfive Pounds, balance thereof, out of moneys provided, or to be provided, by Parliament out of the Consolidated Revenue for the purposes of this Act.
- (2) All moneys provided as aforesaid shall be paid into, or transferred to the credit of, an account to be opened in the Treasury and to be called "The Federal Aid Roads Trust Fund," and all expenditure under this Act shall be debited to such account.
- 8 It shall be lawful for the Treasurer to raise, borrow, and receive Treasurer authora total sum not exceeding Sixty-five thousand six hundred and twenty ised to borrow five Pounds for the purposes of this Act.

9—(1) All Federal aid roads shall, upon and after the completion Provisions for of the construction or reconstruction thereof, as the case may be, be maintenance of adequately and continuously maintained in good repair and condition as follows :-

Federal aid roads.

1. Every Federal aid road which is a main road of the State shall be so maintained as aforesaid by the Board, on behalf of the Minister, under the Main Roads Maintenance Act, 17 Geo. V. No. 1926: and

- II. Every Federal aid road which is not a main road of the State, and which is within the limits of a municipality, shall be so maintained as aforesaid by and at the expense of such municipality, and in any case in which a Federal aid road forms a boundary or boundaries of any adjoining municipalities, the same shall be so maintained as aforesaid by and at the joint expense of such adjoining municipalities.
- (2) If any municipality shall at any time make default in maintaining any Federal aid road which is not a main road of the State, in accordance with the provisions of Paragraph II. of Subsection (1) of this section, the Minister may cause the necessary maintenance work to be carried out by the Board, and the cost of such work may be recovered by the Minister from such municipality under the Crown 55 Vict. No. 25 Remedies Act, 1891, as a debt due to His Majesty.
