

AN ACT to provide for the Construction and A.D. 1882. Execution of certain Public Works. [6 November, 1882,]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of *Tasmania*, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

1 In this Act, unless the context otherwise determines—

Interpretation.

- "The Minister" means the Minister of Lands and Works for the time being, and includes any person appointed by him or acting under his orders.
- 2 It shall be lawful for the Minister to cause to be constructed, Minister to cause completed, improved, or executed, the several Works mentioned in the Schedule (1) and (2), at a cost for each separate Work not exceeding structed. the amounts set forth in the said Schedule respectively.

- 3 The cost of the several Works specified in the Schedule shall be Defrayment of defrayed out of the moneys to be provided by Parliament for that cost of Works.
- 4 All the provisions contained in "The Public Works Construction Provisions of Act, 1880," shall extend and apply to the several Works mentioned in 44 Vict. No. 32, the Schedule to this Act as fully in all respects as if the said provisions to be applicable. had been incorporated in this Act.

Public Works.

Minister empowered to purchase a certain piece of land.

5 The Minister may, if the Governor in Council approves, out of moneys provided by Parliament for that purpose, purchase and acquire, at a price not exceeding Two hundred Pounds, a piece of land at *New Norfolk* for the erection of a Post and Telegraph Station thereon; but such piece of land, as and when the same shall be purchased and acquired by the Minister, shall be conveyed to Her Majesty, Her Heirs and Successors.

Short title.

6 This Act may be cited as "The Public Works Construction Act, 1882, (No. 2)."
