

# AN ACT to provide for the Construction and A.D. 1884. Execution of certain Public Works. [24 November, 1884.]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

1 In this Act, unless the context otherwise determines—
"The Minister" means the Minister of Lands and Works for the time being, and includes any person appointed by him or acting under his orders.

 ${\bf Interpretation.}$ 

2—(1.) It shall be lawful for the Minister to cause to be constructed, Works to be concompleted, improved, or executed, the several Works mentioned structed. in the Schedule, except the Work next specified—

Campbell Town Waterworks, Completion of Works, £1500, at a cost for each separate Work not exceeding the amounts set forth in the said Schedule respectively.

(2.) It shall be lawful for the Treasurer upon the Warrant of the Governor to advance and pay to "The Campbell Town Water Trust" the sum of One thousand five hundred Pounds for the purposes of the Campbell Town Water Acts, 1878 and 1882, to execute the Work specified in the Schedule as follows:—

Campbell Town Waterworks, Completion of Works, £1500.

#### Public Works Construction.

#### A.D. 1884.

Defrayment of cost of Works.

3 The cost of the several Works specified in the Schedule shall be defrayed out of the moneys to be provided by Parliament for that purpose.

Provisions of 44 Vict. No. 32 to be applicable.

4 All the provisions contained in "The Public Works Construction Act, 1880," shall extend and apply to the several Works mentioned in the Schedule to this Act, as fully in all respects as if the said provisions had been incorporated in this Act.

Appropriation of moneys voted by 47 Vict. No. 33.

5 The sum of Two hundred Pounds appropriated by "The Public Works Construction Act, 1883," for the purchase of Jetty at *Victoria*, including approaches, shall and may be applied towards and for the

construction of the said Jetty.

The sum of Three hundred Pounds appropriated by the said Act for purchase of Jetty at Oyster Cove, shall and may be applied towards and for the purchase and repair of the said Jetty.

Appropriation of moneys voted by 47 Vict. No. 34. 6 Out of the sum of Three thousand and two hundred Pounds

appropriated by the Act of the 47th Victoria, No. 34, for—
"Improvements to Harbours, River Mersey, at Latrobe and Torquay; also Harbours, River Leven and River Forth," a sum not exceeding One thousand and three hundred Pounds shall and may be appropriated and paid to "The Mersey Marine Board" for the purchase of Dredger, Barges, and Plant for Dredging purposes.

Short title.

7 This Act may be cited as "The Public Works Construction Act, 1884."
