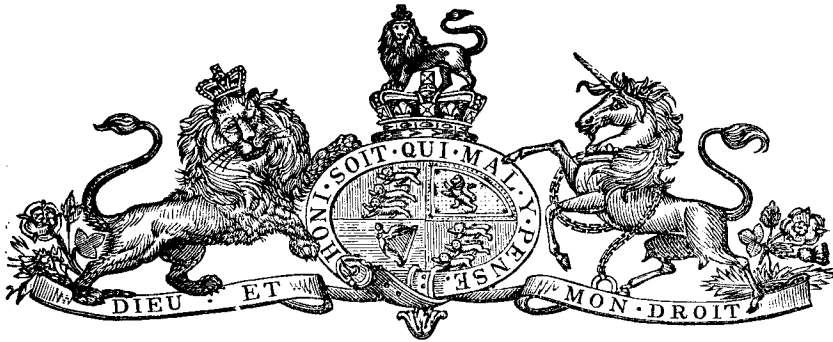

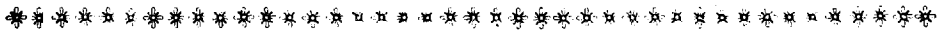

AN ACT to provide for the Construction of A.D. 1889.
certain Public Works. [4 February, 1889.]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of *Tasmania*, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

1 In this Act, unless the context otherwise determines— Interpretation.
“The Minister” means the Minister of Lands and Works for the time being, and includes any person appointed by him or acting under his orders.

2 It shall be lawful for the Minister to cause to be constructed, Works to be con-
completed, improved, or executed, the several Works mentioned in the Schedule, at a cost for each separate Work not exceeding the amounts set forth in the said Schedule respectively.

3 The cost of the several Works specified in the Schedule shall be Defrayment of
defrayed out of the moneys to be provided by Parliament for that purpose. cost of Works.

4 All the provisions contained in “The Public Works Construction Provisions of
Act, 1880,” shall extend and apply to the several Works mentioned in the Schedule to this Act, as fully in all respects as if the said provisions had been incorporated in this Act. 44 Vict. No. 32
to be applicable.

5 The sum of Five hundred Pounds appropriated by "The Public Works Construction Act, 1887," for—

Improvements to Streets, *Leven*, (to be contributed at the rate of £1 for every £1 locally raised and expended for the same purpose),

shall and may be applied towards and for

Improvements to Streets, *Ulverstone*, (to be contributed at the rate of £1 for every £1 locally raised and expended for the same purpose).

Short title.

6 This Act may be cited as "The Public Works Construction Act, 1888."
