AN ACT to provide for the Construction of A.D. 1889.
certain Public Works. [5 December, 1889.] —

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of *Tasmania*, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows :—

1 In this Act, unless the context otherwise determines—

Interpretation.

“The Minister” means the Minister of Lands and Works for the time being, and includes any person appointed by him or acting under his orders.

2 It shall be lawful for the Minister to cause to be constructed, completed, improved, or executed, the several Works mentioned in the Schedule, at a cost for each separate Work not exceeding the amounts set forth in the said Schedule respectively. Works to be constructed.

3 The cost of the several Works specified in the First Part of the Schedule shall be defrayed out of the moneys to be provided by Parliament for that purpose. Defrayment of cost of Works.

4 The cost of the Works specified in the Second Part of the Schedule shall be defrayed out of the Consolidated Revenue Fund of the Colony for the Year 1890; and the Treasurer of the Colony, upon the Governor's Warrant, may issue and pay out of the said Fund any sum or sums of money not exceeding in amount the sum of money in the Second Part of the Schedule specified. Cost of certain Works to be defrayed out of Revenue.

5 All the provisions contained in "The Public Works Construction Act, 1880," shall extend and apply to the several Works mentioned in the Schedule to this Act, as fully in all respects as if the said provisions had been incorporated in this Act.

6 The unexpended balance of the sum of Four hundred and twenty Pounds appropriated by "The Public Works Construction Act, 1886," for and towards the construction of a "Training Wall west side of Leven to Black Jack," shall and may be applied for and towards the construction of a Training Wall east side of Leven to Black Jack.

7 The sums of Three thousand Pounds and Four thousand Pounds respectively appropriated by "The Supplementary Public Works Act, 1887," for and towards Bridges over the River Derwent, shall and may be applied for and towards the construction of a Bridge over the River Derwent near Plenty Junction, and a Bridge over the River Derwent at Arundel, including approaches, and a Bridge over the River Styx.

Short title.

8 This Act may be cited as "The Public Works Construction Act, 1889."
