

AN ACT to provide for the Construction of A.D. 1890. certain Public Works. [15 November, 1890.]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows :---

1 In this Act, unless the context otherwise determines--

"The Minister" means the Minister of Lands and Works for the time being, and includes any person appointed by him or acting under his orders.

2 It shall be lawful for the Minister to cause to be constructed, Works to be concompleted, improved, or executed, the several Works mentioned in the structed. Schedule, at a cost for each separate Work not exceeding the amounts set forth in the said Schedule respectively.

3 The cost of the several Works specified in the said Schedule shall be Defrayment of defrayed out of the moneys to be provided by Parliament for that cost of Works. purpose.

4 All the provisions contained in "The Public Works Construction Provisions of Act, 1880," shall extend and apply to the several Works mentioned in 44 Vict. No. 32 the Schedule to this Act, as fully in all respects as if the said provisions applied. had been incorporated in this Act.

Short title.

5 The sum of Three hundred Pounds, appropriated by "The Public Works Construction Act, 1887," for and towards the construction of a Jetty at *Flower Pot*, *Franklin*, is hereby applied for and towards the construction of a Jetty at *Garth's Point* and at *Brooks*" *Bay* respectively.

6 The words "a training wall east side of *Leven* to *Black Jack*," in the last line of Section Six of "The Public Works Construction Act, 1889," are hereby expunged, and the words "Harbour Improvements, River *Leven*," are inserted in lieu thereof.

7 This Act may be cited as "The Public Works Construction Act, 1890."
