

## AN ACT to provide for the Construction of A.D. 1892. certain Public Works. [21 December, 1892.]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows :----

1 In this Act, unless the context otherwise determines---

"The Minister" means the Minister of Lands and Works for the time being, and includes any person appointed by him or acting under his orders.

2 It shall be lawful for the Minister to cause to be constructed, Works to be concompleted, improved, or executed, the several Works mentioned in the structed. Schedule, at a cost for each separate Work not exceeding the amounts set forth in the said Schedule respectively.

3 The cost of the several Works specified in the said Schedule shall be Defrayment of defrayed out of the moneys to be provided by Parliament for that cost of Works. purpose.

**4** The unexpended balance of the sum of Seven hundred Pounds, Money appropriated by "The Main Roads and Bridges Construction Act, priated by 45 Vict. 1881," for and towards the construction of a Road from "River Blyth to River Emu," shall and may be applied for and towards the construction of the Main Coast Road, west of Penguin Township.

### Public Works Construction.

Corner)," and the sum of Two hundred Pounds, appropriated by "The Public Works Construction Act, 1891," for and towards the construction of a Jetty at "Lady's Bay," shall and may be respectively applied for and towards the construction of a Road from Southport to Lady's Bay.

**6**—(1.) The sum of One hundred and fifty Pounds, appropriated by "The Branch Roads Construction Act, 1891," for and towards the construction of a Road from "*Green Valley* to *Apsley Valley*," shall and may be applied for and towards the construction of a Road from *Green Valley* to *Apsley* Railway.

(2.) The sum of Two hundred Pounds, appropriated by "The Branch Roads Construction Act, 1891," for and towards the construction of a Road from "Constitution Hill to Railway Station at Dysart," shall and may be applied for and towards the construction of a Road from Dysart Station (Apsley Railway) to junction of Hunting Ground Road leading to Green Valley.

Provisions of 44 Vict. No. 32 applied.

Short title.

7 All the provisions contained in "The Public Works Construction Act, 1880," shall extend and apply to the several Works mentioned in the Schedule to this Act, as fully in all respects as if the said provisions had been incorporated in this Act.

8 This Act may be cited as "The Public Works Construction Act, 1892."
