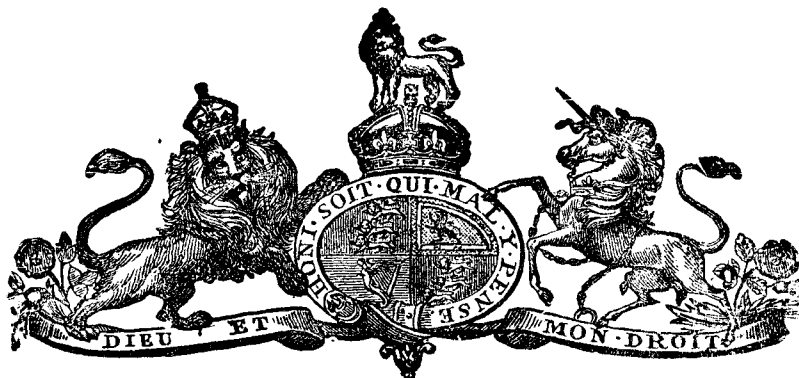

## ANALYSIS.

1. Short title.

AN ACT to provide for the Execution  
of certain Public Works, and for other  
purposes. [24 November, 1925.]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows :—

**1** This Act may be cited as “The Public Works Execution Act (No. 1), 1925.” Short title.

**2** Conditionally on the Hobart City Council, on behalf of the Mayor, aldermen, and citizens of the City of Hobart, contributing one-half of the cost of each of the works specified in the schedule to this Act, it shall be lawful for the Minister to cause to be constructed, improved, executed, or completed the works so specified at a cost for each separate work not exceeding the total amount set forth in the said schedule in respect thereof. Minister may, subject to certain conditions, cause to be constructed the works specified in the schedule.

*Public Works Execution (No. 1).*

Cost, how to be defrayed.

**3** The cost of the said works specified in the schedule shall be defrayed as follows:—

- i. As to the sum of Three thousand six hundred and fifty Pounds, one-half part thereof, out of moneys to be provided by Parliament for the purpose: and
- ii. As to the balance thereof, being a further sum of Three thousand six hundred and fifty Pounds, out of moneys to be provided by the Hobart City Council for the purpose.

Provisions of 44 Vict. No. 32 and 45 Vict. No. 31 to be applicable.

**4** The provisions of the Public Works Construction Act, 1880, and the Branch Roads Construction Act, 1881, shall extend and apply to the works mentioned in the said schedule as fully in all respects as if the said provisions had been incorporated in this Act.

Land required may be acquired under 1 Geo. V. No. 11 at option of Minister.

**5** Notwithstanding anything contained in this or any other Act, any land required for the purpose of any public work specified in the said schedule may, at the option of the Minister, be purchased, acquired, or taken under the Lands Resumption Act, 1910, and in the event of such option being so exercised the provisions of that Act shall accordingly apply, and be deemed to be incorporated with this Act, in lieu of the provisions of the Public Works Construction Act, 1880, and the Branch Roads Construction Act, 1881.
