AN ACT to provide for the Execution of ^{A.D.} 1910.
certain Public Works.

[30 December, 1910.]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

1 This Act may be cited for all purposes as "The Public Works Execution Act, 1910." Short title.

Public Works Execution.

A.D. 1910.

Interpretation.

Minister to cause works to be constructed.

Appropriation for works in schedule.

Money not required for work may be expended by Minister on other works.

Provisions of 44 Vict. No. 32 and 45 Vict. No. 31 to be applicable.

Reappropriation of amount provided under Item 374 in schedule to 7 Ed. VII. No. 31.

Reappropriation of part of amount provided under Item 595 in schedule to 8 Ed. VII. No. 14.

Reappropriation of amount provided under Item 739 in schedule to 8 Ed. VII. No. 14.

2 In this Act, unless the context otherwise determines, "the Minister" means the Minister of Lands and Works for the time being, and includes any person appointed by him or acting under his orders.

3 It shall be lawful for the Minister to cause to be constructed, improved, executed, or completed, the works mentioned in the schedule, at a cost for each separate work not exceeding the amounts set forth in the said schedule.

4 The cost of the several works specified in the schedule shall be defrayed out of moneys to be provided by Parliament for that purpose.

5 If the Minister at any time reports to the Governor that the whole or any portion of the money voted by this Act or any previous Act providing for the execution of public works is not required to be expended upon the work for which such money is voted, it shall be lawful for the Minister to expend such balance, provided it does not exceed Fifty Pounds, upon such other work or works previously authorised by Parliament as he may think fit : Provided that such lastmentioned work is situated in the same city or municipality, as the case may be, as the work for which such money was originally voted.

6 All the provisions contained in "The Public Works Construction Act, 1880," and "The Branch Roads Construction Act, 1881," shall extend and apply to the works mentioned in the said schedule as fully in all respects as if the said provisions had been incorporated in this Act.

7 It shall be lawful for the Minister to expend the sum of Seventy-five Pounds, appropriated for Item 374 of the schedule to the Act 7 Edwardi VII. No. 31, towards the construction, improvement, execution, or completion of the following road, namely :—Road to selections of *Rothall, Daw*, and others ; and it shall be lawful for the Treasurer to reappropriate the same accordingly.

8 It shall be lawful for the Minister to expend the sum of Five hundred and five Pounds out of the amount appropriated for Item 595 of the schedule to the Act 8 Edwardi VII. No. 14, towards the purchase of land at *Long Point, Sandy Bay*, for purposes of public recreation and amusement ; and it shall be lawful for the Treasurer to reappropriate the same accordingly.

9 It shall be lawful for the Minister to expend the sum of Two hundred Pounds, appropriated for Item 739 of the schedule to the Act 8 Edwardi VII. No. 14, towards the construction, improvement, execution, or completion of the following road, namely :—Road to

Magnet Township ; and it shall be lawful for the Treasurer to reappropriate the same accordingly. A.D. 1910.

10 It shall be lawful for the Minister to expend the sum of One hundred Pounds, appropriated for Item 231 of the schedule to "The Public Works Execution Act, 1909," towards the construction, improvement, execution, or completion of the following roads, as follows, namely :—Fifty Pounds for *Montrose*-road, and Fifty Pounds for the branch road to the selections of *Pierce*, *Walker*, and *Jacques* ; and it shall be lawful for the Treasurer to reappropriate the same accordingly.

11 It shall be lawful for the Minister to expend the sum of Ninety Pounds out of the amount appropriated for Item 347 of the schedule to "The Public Works Execution Act, 1909," towards the construction, improvement, execution, or completion of the following road, namely, *Frankford* and *Green's Creek* Road from *Frankford* Bridge to *Sexton's Creek* ; and it shall be lawful for the Treasurer to reappropriate the same accordingly.

12 It shall be lawful for the Minister to expend sums exceeding One thousand Pounds in construction of State schools at *Charles-street*, *Launceston*, and *Battery Point, Hobart*, out of the sum of Fourteen thousand Pounds under Item 967 of the schedule hereto.
