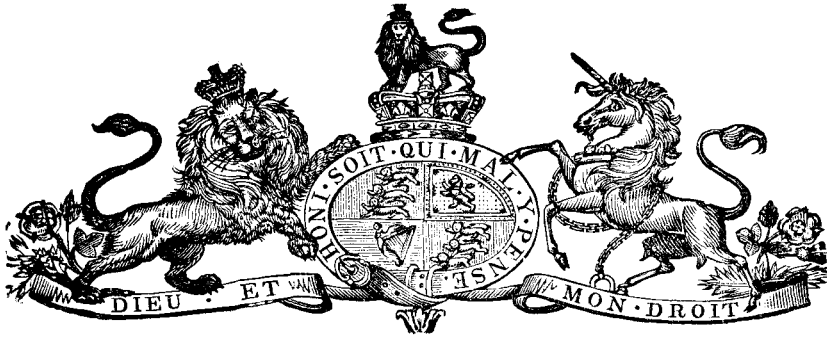

AN ACT to provide for the Execution of <sup>A.D.</sup> 1933.  
certain Public Works. [12 December, 1933.]

**BE** it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows :—

**1** This Act may be cited as “The Public Works Execution Act, Short title. 1933.”

**2** The Minister may cause the works specified in Schedules (1) and (2) to be undertaken and executed, at a cost not exceeding in each case the amount set forth in the schedule in respect of each work.

**3** The Treasurer may reappropriate the sums specified in Schedule (3), being the unexpended balances of the amounts appropriated for the items set forth in that schedule, and apply the aggregate thereof, amounting to the sum of One hundred and one thousand eight hundred and ninety-four Pounds Seventeen Shillings, in defraying the cost of the works authorised by this Act.

**4** The Minister may expend the amount authorised by Item 528 in Schedule (2) of the Public Works Execution Act, 1929 (being the Item "Kellevie to Bloomfield's, Spaulding's, and others, Sorell Municipality, £100"), on road, Bream Creek to Nugent, *via* Kellevie.

**5** The Minister may expend the amount of £100, authorised by Paragraph 1. of Section Five of the Public Works Execution Act, 1932, in respect of the Item "Allen's Rivulet Road, top end," Kingborough Municipality, on Road to Trevor Mathews and others, Longley.

**6** If any part of the moneys provided by this Act is not required for the purposes of the work for which it was provided, the Minister may expend the whole or any part of any such unexpended balance which does not exceed Fifty Pounds upon any other work which has been authorised by Parliament in respect of the same city or municipality as that in respect of which the amount was originally provided.

**7** The provisions of the Public Works Construction Act, 1880, and the Branch Roads Construction Act, 1881, shall apply to any public works constructed under this Act in the same manner as if those provisions had been incorporated in this Act.

**8** Any land required for the purpose of any public works constructed under this Act, at the option of the Minister, may be acquired under the Lands Resumption Act, 1910, or the Land Vesting Act, 1894.
