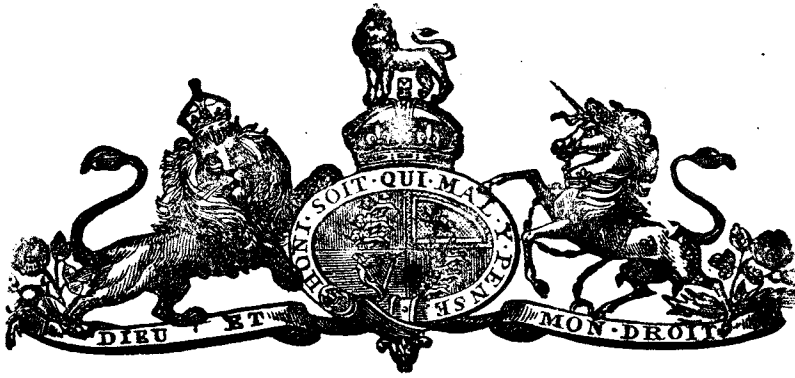

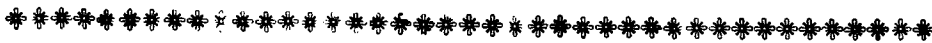

AN ACT to provide for the Execution of certain Public Works. [10 *January*, 1912.] A.D.
1911

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows :—

1 This Act may be cited for all purposes as “The Public Works Short title. Execution Act (No. 2), 1911.”

Public Works Execution (No. 2).

A.D. 1911.

Interpretation.

2 In this Act, unless the context otherwise determines, "the Minister" means the Minister of Lands and Works for the time being, and includes any person appointed by him or acting under his orders.

Minister to cause works to be constructed.

3 It shall be lawful for the Minister to cause to be constructed, improved, executed, or completed, the works mentioned in the schedule, at a cost for each separate work not exceeding the amounts set forth in the said schedule.

Appropriation for works in schedule.

4 The cost of the several works specified in the schedule shall be defrayed out of moneys to be provided by Parliament for that purpose.

Money not required for work may be expended by Minister on other works.

5 If the Minister at any time reports to the Governor that the whole or any portion of the money voted by this Act or any previous Act providing for the execution of public works is not required to be expended upon the work for which such money is voted, it shall be lawful for the Minister to expend such balance, provided it does not exceed Fifty Pounds, upon such other work or works previously authorised by Parliament as he may think fit: Provided that such lastmentioned work is situated in the same city or municipality, as the case may be, as the work for which such money was originally voted.

Provisions of 44 Vic. No. 32 and 45 Vic. No. 31 to be applicable.

6 All the provisions contained in "The Public Works Construction Act, 1880," and "The Branch Roads Construction Act, 1881," shall extend and apply to the works mentioned in the said schedule as fully in all respects as if the said provisions had been incorporated in this Act.

Reappropriation of amounts of Item 340 in schedule to 7 Ed. VII. No. 31, and Item 549 in schedule to 1 Geo. V. No 51.

7 It shall be lawful for the Minister to expend the sum of Four hundred Pounds appropriated for Item 340 of the schedule to the Act 7 Ed. VII. No. 31, and also the sum of Two hundred Pounds appropriated for Item 549 of the schedule to the Act 1 Geo. V. No. 51, towards the construction, improvement, execution, or completion of the following road, namely:—Butleigh Hill Road, crossing railway line to the road leading from Wilmore's Lane to Little Hampton station; and the Treasurer may reappropriate the same accordingly.

Reappropriation of amount of Item 717 in schedule to 9 Ed. VII. No. 51.

8 It shall be lawful for the Minister to expend the sum of One hundred and fifty Pounds appropriated for Item 717 of the schedule to the Act 9 Ed. VII. No. 51 towards the construction, improvement, execution or completion of the following road, namely:—Esplanade Road, South Lindisfarne; and it shall be lawful for the Treasurer to reappropriate the same accordingly.
