# AN ACT to provide for the Execution of 1912. certain Public Works. [17 December, 1912.]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

1 This Act may be cited for all purposes as "The Public Works Short title. Execution Act (No. 2), 1912."

A.D 1912.

Interpretation.

2 In this Act, unless the context otherwise determines, "the Minister" means the Minister of Lands and Works for the time being, and includes any person appointed by him or acting under hisorders.

Minister to cause works to be constructed.

3 It shall be lawful for the Minister to cause to be constructed, improved, executed, or completed, the works mentioned in the schedule, at a cost for each separate work not exceeding the amounts set forth in the said schedule.

Appropriation for works in schedule.

4 The cost of the several works specified in the schedule shall be defrayed out of moneys to be provided by Parliament for that purpose.

Money not required for work may be expended by Minister on other works. 5 If the Minister at any time reports to the Governor that the whole or any portion of the money voted by this Act or any previous Act providing for the execution of public works is not required to be expended upon the work for which such money is voted, it shall be lawful for the Minister to expend such balance, provided it does not exceed Fifty Pounds, upon such other work or works previously authorised by Parliament as he may think fit: Provided that such lastmentioned work is situated in the same city or municipality, as the case may be, as the work for which such money was originally voted.

Provisions of 44 Vict. No. 32 and 45 Vict. No. 31 to be applicable. 6 All the provisions contained in "The Public Works Construction Act, 1880," and "The Branch Roads Construction Act, 1881," shall extend and apply to the works mentioned in the said schedule as fully in all respects as if the said provisions had been incorporated in this Act.

Power to expend £4000, Item 1059, on harbour works, King Island, conditionally.

7 It shall be lawful for the Minister to expend the sum of Four thousand Pounds to be appropriated for Item 1059 of the schedule to this Act, for or towards the construction, improvement, erection, or completion of such harbour works on the east coast of King Island as the Minister thinks proper, conditionally upon provision being made locally, to the satisfaction of the Minister, for the payment of interest upon the amount of such expenditure, and the formation of a sinking fund to liquidate such amount, and upon such other terms and conditions as the Minister may impose being complied with locally.

Reappropriation of amount provided under Item 995 of schedule to 1 Geo. V. No 51. 8 It shall be lawful for the Minister to expend the sum of Eighty thousand Pounds appropriated for Item 995 of the schedule to "The Public Works Execution Act, 1910," for and towards the survey and construction of the following tramways or any of them, viz.:—

Ulverstone southwards towards Nietta,

From Penguin southwards,

From Flowerdale line towards Preolenna,

Huon River to timber areas or Crown lands in back districts.

And it shall be lawful for the Treasurer to reappropriate the same A.D. 1912. accordingly.

- 9 The schedule to "The Public Works Execution Act (No. 1), 2 Geo. V. No. 3 1911," is hereby amended as from the commencement of that Act, in as to Item 163. regard to Item 163 by omitting the words "(Conditional upon a like amount being provided locally).
- 10 The Treasurer shall cause all moneys received from time to time Appropriation of by way of rent from the Mersey Marine Board and the Leven Harbour certain rents to Trust under any agreement now or hereafter entered into with the redeem £4000, Minister in relation to the undermentioned dredges to be paid to the Commissioners of the Public Debts Sinking Fund for the purpose of redeeming the sum of Four thousand Pounds to be appropriated for Item 1085 of the schedule to this Act namely, repairs to dredges "Agnew" and "Davenport" until the Auditor-General shall certify that the said sum has been thereby redeemed.

11 It shall be lawful for the Minister out of any moneys to be Power to provided for that purpose by Parliament to contribute any sum or sums of money not exceeding in the whole the sum of Eleven thousand Pounds towards the cost of effecting a certain diversion of the Hobart Rivulet Hobart Rivulet, and the construction of a certain tunnel therefrom, and and construction other works for the effecting or construction whereof statutory powers are of certain works, being applied for by the Corporation of Hobart and the Marine Board of Hobart: Provided that no such contribution shall be made unless the Corporation of Hobart and the Marine Board of Hobart shall make such concessions and comply with such terms and conditions as the Minister shall require or impose.
