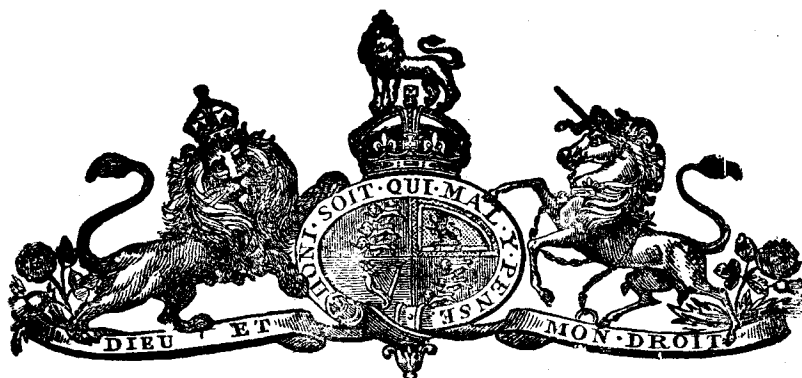

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AN ACT to provide for the Execution of certain Public Works, the Acquisition of Land, and for other purposes.

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

1 This Act may be cited for all purposes as "The Public Works Execution Act (No. 2), 1918."

Public Works Execution (No. 2).

A.D. 1918.

Interpretation.

Minister may cause works to be constructed.

Reappropriation for Franklin Reclamation Works of certain unexpended balances, &c., as follows:—
£300 reappropriated from Item "Dredging and Snagging Huon River."

£4649 10s. reappropriated from Item "Dredging Huon River."

1 Geo. V. No. 51.
£3121 18s. 6d. reappropriated from Item "Dredging Huon River."

Provisions of 44 Vict. No. 32 and 45 Vict. No. 31, at option applicable.

Land required may be acquired under 1 Geo. V. No. 11, at option of Minister.

2 In this Act, unless the context otherwise determines, "the Minister" means the Minister of Lands and Works for the time being, and includes any person appointed by him or acting under his orders.

3 It shall be lawful for the Minister to cause the Franklin Reclamation Works to be constructed, improved, executed, or completed at a cost not exceeding the total amount reappropriated for the purpose under the next succeeding section.

4 It shall be lawful for the Minister to expend in or towards the construction, erection, improvement, or completion of the Franklin Reclamation Works the following moneys, namely:—

- I. The sum of Three hundred Pounds appropriated for item Seven hundred and twenty (Dredging and Snagging, Huon River) of the schedule to "The Public Works Execution Act, 1909"; and
- II. The sum of Four thousand six hundred and forty-nine Pounds and Ten Shillings, being the unexpended balance of Five thousand Pounds appropriated for item Nine hundred and forty-three (Dredging Huon River) of the schedule to "The Public Works Execution Act, 1910"; and
- III. The sum of Three thousand one hundred and twenty-one Pounds Eighteen Shillings and Six Pence, being the unexpended balance of Five thousand Pounds appropriated for item One thousand and sixty-one (Dredging the Huon River) of the schedule to "The Public Works Execution Act, 1913";

and it shall be lawful for the Treasurer to reappropriate accordingly the moneys to be so expended.

5 All the provisions contained in "The Public Works Construction Act, 1880," and "The Branch Roads Construction Act, 1881," shall extend and apply to the Franklin Reclamation Works and the works mentioned in the schedule to this Act as fully in all respects as if the said provisions had been incorporated in this Act.

6 Notwithstanding anything contained in this Act or any Act incorporated therewith, any land required for the purposes of the Franklin Reclamation Works or the works mentioned in the schedule to this Act may, at the option of the Minister, be purchased, acquired, or taken under "The Lands Resumption Act, 1910," and in the event of such option being so exercised the provisions of that Act shall accordingly apply, and be deemed to be incorporated with this Act, in lieu of the provisions of "The Public Works Construction Act, 1880," and "The Branch Roads Construction Act, 1881," incorporated with this Act.

Public Works Execution (No. 2).

7 It shall be lawful for the Minister to cause to be constructed, improved, executed, or completed, the works specified in the schedule to this Act at a cost for each separate work not exceeding the amounts set forth in the said schedule.

Minister to cause works to be constructed.

8 The cost of the several works specified in the schedule to this Act shall be defrayed out of moneys to be provided by Parliament for that purpose.
