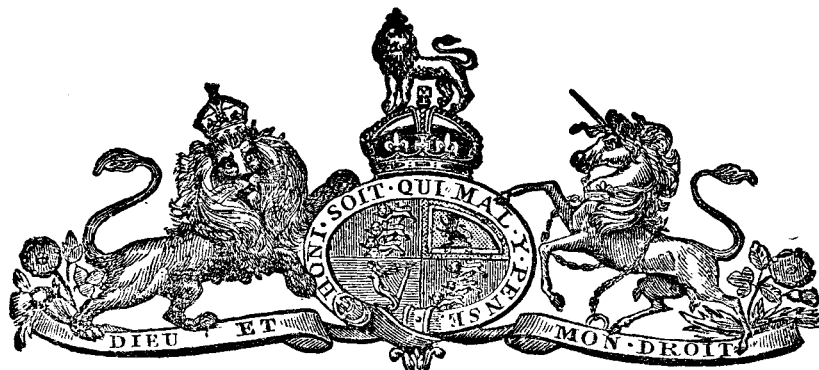

AN ACT to provide for the Execution of a certain Public Work. [18 March, 1924.]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

**1** This Act may be cited as “The Public Works Execution Act (No. 2), 1924.” Short title.

**2** It shall be lawful for the Minister to cause to be constructed, improved, executed, or completed the work specified in the Schedule to this Act at a cost, not exceeding the amount set forth therein, to be defrayed out of moneys to be provided by Parliament for that purpose. Power to Minister to cause work to be constructed, &c.

**3** All the provisions of “The Public Works Construction Act, 1880,” shall extend and apply to the work mentioned in this Act in the same manner as if such provisions were incorporated in this Act. Provisions of 45 Vic. No. 32 to apply.
