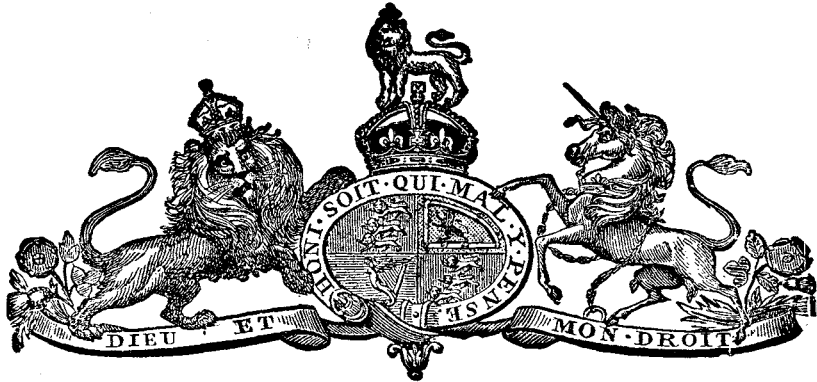

AN ACT to provide for the Execution of ^{A.D.} 1933.
certain Public Works. [10 January, 1934] —

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

1 This Act may be cited as “The Public Works Execution Act Short title. (No. 2), 1933.”

2 The Minister may cause the works specified in the schedule to be undertaken and executed, at a cost not exceeding in each case the amount set forth in the schedule in respect of each work.

3 The Treasurer may raise, borrow, and receive for the purposes of this Act any sum or sums of money not exceeding in the aggregate the sum of Eighteen thousand Pounds.

4 The provisions of the Public Works Construction Act, 1880, and the Branch Roads Construction Act, 1881, shall apply to the works constructed under this Act in the same manner as if those provisions had been incorporated in this Act.

5 Any land required for the purposes of the works constructed under this Act, at the option of the Minister, may be acquired under the Lands Resumption Act, 1910, or the Land Vesting Act, 1894.
