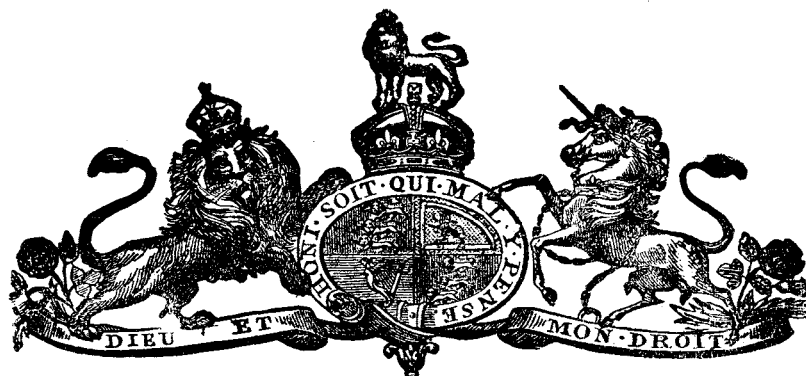

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AN ACT to provide for the Execution of ^{A.D.} 1925.
 certain Public Works, and for other purposes.
 [9 December, 1925.]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows :—

1 This Act may be cited as “The Public Works Execution Act Short title. (No. 3), 1925.”

2 In this Act “schedule” means schedule to this Act.

Interpretation.

Public Works Execution (No. 3).

A.D. 1925.

Minister may cause to be constructed the works specified in Schedule (1).

Cost of works, how to be defrayed.

Money not required for work may be expended by Minister on other works.

3 It shall be lawful for the Minister to cause to be constructed, improved, executed, or completed the works specified in Schedule (1) at a cost for each separate work not exceeding the amount set forth in the said schedule in respect thereof.

4 The cost of the works specified in Schedule (1) shall be defrayed out of moneys to be provided by Parliament for the purpose.

5 If the Minister at any time reports to the Governor that the whole or any portion of the money voted by this Act for any of the works mentioned in Schedule (1) is not required for the work for which such money is voted, it shall be lawful for the Minister to expend the balance of such money, provided it does not exceed Fifty Pounds, upon such other work or works previously authorised by Parliament as he may think fit: Provided that such lastmentioned work is situated in such city or municipality, as the case may be, as the work for which such money was originally voted.

Provisions of 44 Vict. No. 32 and 45 Vict. No. 31 to be applicable.

6 The provisions of the Public Works Construction Act, 1880, and the Branch Roads Construction Act, 1881, shall extend and apply to the works mentioned in Schedule (1) as fully in all respects as if the said provisions had been incorporated in this Act.

Land required may be acquired under 1 Geo. V. No. 11 at option of Minister.

7 Notwithstanding anything contained in this or any other Act, any land required for the purpose of any public work specified in Schedule (1) may, at the option of the Minister, be purchased, acquired, or taken under the Lands Resumption Act, 1910, and in the event of such option being so exercised the provisions of that Act shall accordingly apply, and be deemed to be incorporated with this Act, in lieu of the provisions of the Public Works Construction Act, 1880, and the Branch Roads Construction Act, 1881.

Retrospective operation of Sections 3 to 7 inclusive.

8 Sections Three to Seven inclusive of this Act shall be deemed to have come into operation on the first day of March, one thousand nine hundred and twenty-five.

Minister may, subject to certain conditions, cause to be constructed the work specified in Schedule (2).

9 Conditionally on the Municipal Council of the City of Launceston, on behalf of the Mayor, aldermen, and citizens of the said City of Launceston contributing one-half of the cost of the work specified in Schedule (2), it shall be lawful for the Minister to cause to be constructed, improved, executed, or completed the work so specified at a cost not exceeding the amount set forth in the said schedule in respect thereof.

Cost, how to be defrayed.

10 The cost of the said work specified in Schedule (2) shall be defrayed as follows:—

1. As to the sum of Two thousand seven hundred and twenty-five Pounds, one-half part thereof, out of moneys to be provided by Parliament for the purpose: and

- ii. As to the balance thereof, being a further sum of Two thousand seven hundred and twenty-five Pounds, out of moneys to be provided by the Municipal Council of the City of Launceston for the purpose. A.D. 1925.

11 Conditionally on the Council of the Municipality of Scottsdale, on behalf of the Warden, councillors, and electors of the said municipality contributing one-half of the cost of the work specified in Schedule (3), it shall be lawful for the Minister to cause to be executed and carried out the works so specified, at a cost not exceeding the amount set forth in the said schedule in respect thereof. Minister may, subject to certain conditions, cause to be constructed the works specified in Schedule (3).

12 The cost of the said works specified in Schedule (3) shall be defrayed as follows :— Cost, how to be defrayed.

- i. As to the sum of Two hundred Pounds, one-half part thereof, out of moneys to be provided by Parliament for the purpose: and
- ii. As to the balance thereof, being a further sum of Two hundred Pounds, out of moneys to be provided by the Council of the Municipality of Scottsdale.
