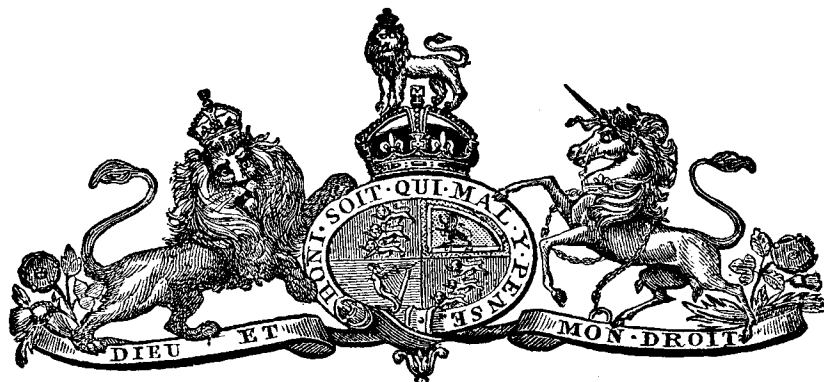

AN ACT to provide for the Execution of certain Public Works. [13 November, 1929.]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

1 This Act may be cited as “The Public Works Execution (Federal Aid Roads) Act (No. 1), 1929.” Short title.

2 It shall be lawful for the Minister to cause to be constructed, improved, executed, or completed the works specified in the schedule to this Act at a cost for each separate work not exceeding the amount set forth in the said schedule in respect thereof. Power to Minister to carry out works.

Public Works Execution (Federal Aid Roads) (No. 1).

Incorporation of provisions of 44 Vict. No. 32 and 45 Vict. No. 31.

3 Subject to the provisions of Section Four hereof, the provisions of the Public Works Construction Act, 1880, and the Branch Roads Construction Act, 1881, shall extend and apply to the works mentioned in the schedule to this Act as fully in all respects as if the said provisions had been incorporated in this Act.

Optional application of 1 Geo. V. No. 11 or 58 Vict No. 17.

4 At the option of the Minister any land required for the purpose of any public work authorised by this Act may be purchased, acquired, or taken under the Lands Resumption Act, 1910, or under the Land Vesting Act, 1894, and, in the event of such option being exercised in respect of either of those Acts for the purposes of such work, the provisions of such Act shall be deemed to be incorporated with this Act for such purposes in lieu of the provisions of the Acts mentioned in Section Three hereof.

Reappropriation of £68,933 borrowed under 13 Geo. V. No. 8.

5 It shall be lawful for the Treasurer to reappropriate and apply for the purposes of this Act the sum of Sixty-eight thousand nine hundred and thirty-three Pounds, being portion of the moneys authorised to be expended for the purposes of the Loans Act (No. 2), 1922-23.
