

AN ACT to authorise the raising of Money for the Construction of certain Public Works. [29 August, 1865.]

WHEREAS it is expedient to raise, by Loans secured on the Land PREAMBLE. Fund, Funds for the construction of certain Public Works: Be it therefore enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows :-

1 It shall be lawful for the Governor in Council to cause to be Power to raise raised by the issue and sale of Debentures secured on the Land Fund, $\pounds 102,569$ 9s. 7d. in like manner as is prescribed in the Act of the Parliament of *Tasmania* for Public Works of the 20th *Victoria*, No. 9, such sum or sums of money, not exceeding in the whole $\pounds 102,569$ 9s. 7d., as may be required for the purpose of Land Fund. defraying the cost of constructing and completing the Public Works authorised to be constructed and completed by The Public Works Act, 1865; such Debentures to bear Interest at a rate not exceeding £6 per centum per annum, and to be redeemable in the year 1895.

2 All and every the clauses, provisions, powers, penalties, forfeitures, Provisions of and disabilities contained in the said Act of the 20th Victoria, No. 9, 20 Vict. No. 9, shall apply and extend to the Debentures to be issued in pursuance of this Act, as fully and effectually to all intents and purposes as if the Debentures. several clauses, provisions, powers, penalties, forfeitures, and disabilities had been particularly repeated and re-enacted in this Act.

3 In referring to this Act it shall be sufficient to make use of the Short Title. expression *The Public Works Loans Act*, 1865.
