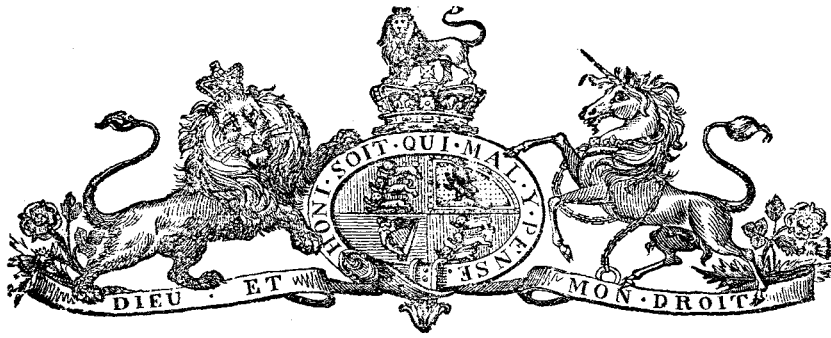

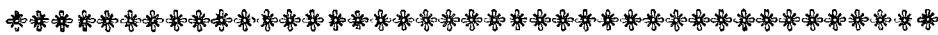

AN ACT to authorise the raising of the Sum of £10,900 by Debentures.

[17 September, 1868.]

WHEREAS it is expedient to raise the Sum of £10,900 by Debentures, secured on the General Revenue and the Land Fund, for the purposes of this Act: Be it therefore enacted by His Excellency the Governor of *Tasmania*, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

PREAMBLE.

1 It shall be lawful for the Governor in Council to cause to be raised by the issue and sale of Debentures secured on the General Revenue, in like manner as is prescribed in the Act 20th *Victoria*, No. 9, such Sum or Sums of money not exceeding in the whole £4900, for the purpose of defraying the cost of the Public Works mentioned in "The Public Works Act, 1868," and such Debentures shall be redeemable in the year 1877.

Governor in Council may raise £4900 by Debentures on General Revenue.

2 It shall be lawful for the Governor in Council to cause to be raised by the issue and sale of Debentures secured on the Land Fund, in like manner as is prescribed in the Act 20th *Victoria*, No. 9, such Sum or Sums of money not exceeding in the whole £6000, as may be required for the purposes of "The Main Line Railway Survey Act;" and such Debentures shall be redeemable in the year 1877.

Governor in Council may raise £6000 by Debentures on Land Fund.

3 All the provisions contained in the said Act of the 20th *Victoria*, No. 9, shall apply and extend to the Debentures to be issued in pursuance of this Act.

20 Vict. No. 9, to apply to such Debentures.

4 This Act may be cited as "The Public Works Loans Act, 1868."
