AN ACT to further amend "The Roads Act, A.D. 1903.
1884." [23 December, 1903.]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of *Tasmania*, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

1 This Act may be cited as "The Roads Act, 1901."

Short title.

2 In this Act "the said Act" shall mean "The Roads Act, 1884."

Interpretation.

3 Section Fifty-six of the said Act is hereby repealed.

Trustees may
make and levy a
Road Rate.

4 It shall be lawful for the Trustees, at yearly, half-yearly, or such other periods as to them may seem necessary, to make and levy a Rate, to be called the Road Rate, upon the annual value of the property within the Road District, for the purpose of carrying out in the Road District the several objects of the said Act; and every such Road Rate, when received, shall form part of the moneys at the disposal of the Trustees for the purposes of the said Act which are applicable to such Trustees.

Provided, that such Road Rate so to be made and levied, shall not in any case exceed, in any one year, the sum of One Shilling and Threepence in the Pound, upon the annual value of the property within the Road District.

Subsidy to Trusts
levying more

5 Out of the Consolidated Revenue Fund there shall be payable, subject as hereinafter provided, by the Treasurer in each year, to the Trustees of any Road District, where such Trustees have levied a Road Rate exceeding One Shilling in the Pound on the annual value of the property in such Road District for the year immediately preceding and ending the Twenty-eighth day of *February*, a sum equal to the amount of money collected by reason of such Rate over and above the amount of money which would have been collected if such Rate had been a Rate of One Shilling in the Pound.

6 No subsidy shall be payable or paid under this Act to the Trustees of any Road District to which this Act applies unless the Statement and Account for the preceding year of such Trustees, as required by the said Act, are forwarded to the Auditor-General before the Thirty-first day of *March* in any year.

Acts to be read
together.

7 This Act and the said Act shall be read and construed together as one and the same Act.
