



AN ACT to further amend "The Real and Personal Estates Duties Act, 1880." A.D. 1885.

[5 December, 1885.]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of *Tasmania*, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

**1** The Duty charged on all lands in *Tasmania* under Schedule (A.) of "The Real and Personal Estates Duties Act, 1880," shall, in the year 1886, and in every subsequent year, be the sum of Ninepence for every Twenty Shillings of the assessed annual value thereof, and a proportionate sum for any part of such Twenty Shillings. Duty under Schedule (A.) to be 9d. in the £ in 1886 and afterwards. 43 Vict. No. 12.

**2** The said Act, and every Act amending the same, and this Act, shall be read and construed together as one Act. Acts to be read together.

**3** This Act may be cited as "The Real and Personal Estates Duties Amendment Act, 1885." Short title.
