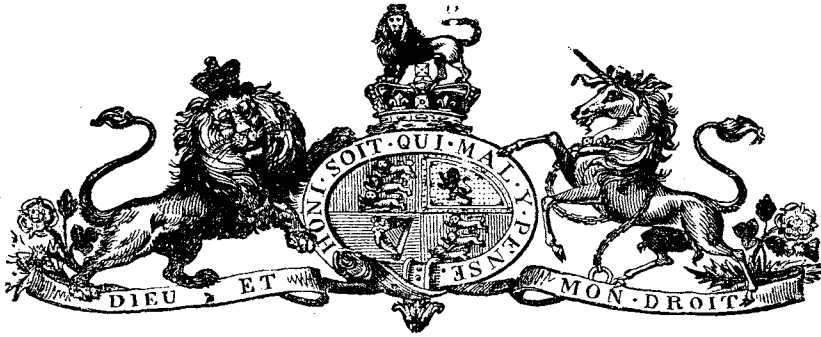

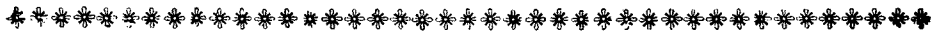

AN ACT to further amend "The Real and Personal Estates Duties Act, 1880." A.D. 1889.
[9 November, 1889.]

WHEREAS it is expedient to further amend "The Real and Personal Estates Duties Act, 1880," in the manner hereinafter appearing : PREAMBLE.
43 Vict. No. 12.

Be it therefore enacted by His Excellency the Governor of *Tasmania*, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

1 This Act may be cited as "The Real and Personal Estates Duties Amendment Act, 1889." Short title.

2 In this Act the expression "the said Act" shall mean "The Real and Personal Estates Duties Act, 1880." Interpretation.

3 If any person shall dispute his liability to pay any Duty under the provisions of the said Act, whether such liability shall have arisen before or after the passing of this Act, such dispute may be summarily settled by a Judge of the Supreme Court sitting in Chambers. Disputes may be settled by Judge.

4 This Act and the said Act, and every Act amending the same, shall be read and construed together as one Act. Acts to be read together.
