

AN ACT to further amend "The Real and A.D. 1889. Personal Estates Duties Act, 1880." [9 November, 1889.]

WHEREAS it is expedient to further amend "The Real and PREAMBLE.
Personal Estates Duties Act, 1880," in the manner hereinafter 43 Vict. No. 12. appearing:

Be it therefore enacted by His Excellency the Governor of *Tasmania*, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

- 1 This Act may be cited as "The Real and Personal Estates Short title. Duties Amendment Act, 1889."
- 2 In this Act the expression "the said Act" shall mean "The Interpretation. Real and Personal Estates Duties Act, 1880."
- 3 If any person shall dispute his liability to pay any Duty under the provisions of the said Act, whether such liability shall have arisen before or after the passing of this Act, such dispute may be summarily settled by a Judge of the Supreme Court sitting in Chambers.
- 4 This Act and the said Act, and every Act amending the same, Acts to be read shall be read and construed together as one Act.
