AN ACT to further amend "The Railway Management Act, 1891." [30 October, 1896.] A.D. 1896.

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of *Tasmania*, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows :—

1 This Act may be cited as "The Railway Management Act, 1896." Short title.

2 It shall not be lawful for any person to mine for gold or other metals or minerals under any railway or tramway which is subject to the provisions of "The Railway Management Act, 1891," at a depth of less than Fifty feet from the level of such railway or tramway when the same is constructed on the natural surface of the land or in any cutting, or at a depth of less than Fifty feet from the natural surface of the land when such railway or tramway is constructed upon any embankment, notwithstanding that such person is the holder of a lease from the Crown to mine for gold or other metals or minerals upon the land upon which such railway or tramway is constructed. Persons not entitled to mine below any railway at less depth than Fifty feet. 55 Vict. No. 40.

3 This Act and "The Railway Management Act, 1891," shall be read and construed together as one and the same Act. Acts to be read together. 55 Vict. No. 40.
