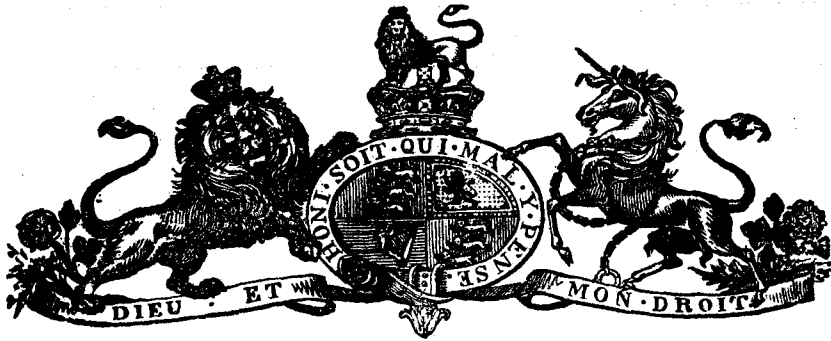

AN ACT to further amend *The Rural Municipalities Act, 1865.* [30 September, 1875.] A.D. 1875.

WHEREAS it is expedient and necessary to further amend *The Rural Municipalities Act, 1865:* PREAMBLE. 29 Vict. No. 8.

Be it therefore enacted by His Excellency the Governor of *Tasmania*, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

1 Notwithstanding anything to the contrary contained in the One hundred and thirty-eighth Section of *The Rural Municipalities Act, 1865*, it shall be lawful for the Municipal Council of any Rural Municipality to direct that any Special Rate made under the said Section shall be payable yearly instead of half-yearly as provided in the said Section. Special Rate may be made payable yearly.

2 This Act, and *The Rural Municipalities Act, 1865*, and every Act altering or amending the same shall, except in so far as any of the said Acts may be altered or amended by this Act, be read and construed together as one and the same Act. Acts to be read together.

3 This Act may be cited as "*The Rural Municipalities Amendment Act, 1875.*" Short title.
