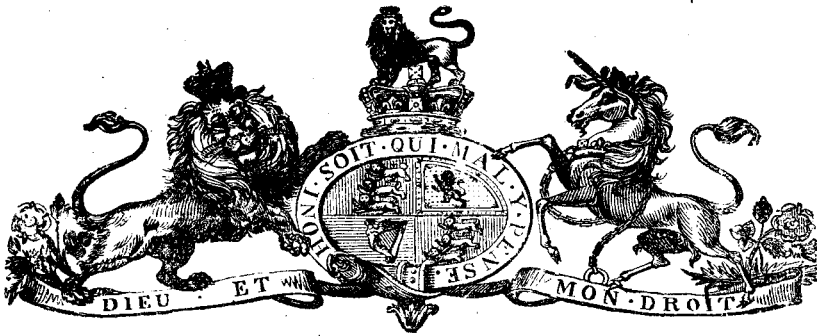

AN ACT to amend "The Railway Management Act, 1891." [30 December, 1901.] A.D. 1901

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of *Tasmania*, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

1 This Act may be cited as "The Railway Management Amendment Act, 1901." Short title.

2 The words "the said Act" shall mean "The Railway Management Act, 1891." Interpretation. 55 Vict No. 40.

3 The interpretation of the word "Minister" in Section Five of the said Act is hereby repealed, and in lieu thereof the word "Minister," when used in the said Act, and in any amendment thereof, shall mean the Responsible Minister of the Crown for the time being administering the said Act, who shall, when administering the said Act, be called or styled "The Minister for Railways" Amendment of Section Five of the said Act.

4 This Act and the said Act, and every Act amending the same, shall be read and construed together as one Act. Acts to be read together.
