

ANALYSIS.

- 1. Short title.
- 2. Certain persons whose lands have been forfeited may be reinstated as
- 3. Certain persons may be permitted to complete their purchases.
- 4. Commissioner may grant new lease of Domain Slip to Hobart Marine Board.
- 5. Power to exchange certain land with Harry Benjafield.
- 6. Commissioner may sell certain land to Helen Coleman.

AN ACT to provide for the Reinstatement of 1914. certain Persons as Purchasers of certain Crown Lands, and for other purposes.

[6 February, 1915.]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

- 1 This Act may be cited as "The Reinstatement of Crown Lands Short title. Purchasers Act, 1914."
- 2 The Commissioner of Crown Lands may, with the consent of the Certain persons Governor, reinstate the persons named in Schedule (1) hereto as purbeen forfeited chasers of the several lots or areas of land set opposite to their names may be reinstated under the provisions of the Acts regulating the sale or disposition of as purchasers. respectively made; and thereupon such persons shall be liable to pay all instalments upon such lands at the date of forfeiture, and all instalments thereafter due thereon, together with the amount of fines and charges for the cost of advertising, as provided in Section Ninetysix of "The Crown Lands Act, 1911," together with interest at the rate of Five Pounds per centum per annum from the date when such instalments became due.

Certain persons named in Schedule (2) to be permitted to complete their purchases. 3 Notwithstanding anything to the contrary contained in any repealed or existing Act regulating the sale or disposition of Lands of the Crown, it shall be lawful for the Commissioner of Crown Lands to permit the persons named in Schedule (2) hereto to complete the purchase of the several areas of land set opposite to their names; and upon payment of the balance of purchase-money into the Treasury, together with a grant fee of Fifteen Shillings, the Governor is hereby authorised, in the name and on behalf of His Majesty the King, to convey and alienate the said lands to the said persons respectively, in fee simple, or for any less estate or interest.

On surrender of present lease Commissioner may grant new lease of Domain Slip to Hobart Marine Board.

4 In consideration of the Hobart Marine Board surrendering all their right, title, and interest in their present lease of the premises known as the Domain Slip, the Commissioner of Crown Lands is hereby authorised to lease the said premises to the Hobart Marine Board, for a period not exceeding Ninety-nine years, on such terms and conditions as he may think fit, and subject to such reservations thereout of any portion thereof which may be required for Commonwealth purposes.

Power to exchange certain land in Parish of Hobart with Harry Benjafield Schedule (3).

5 In consideration of Harry Benjafield having executed a surrender to His Majesty the King of all his right, title, and interest in certain land in the town of Moonah for railway purposes, it shall be lawful for the Governor, in the name and on behalf of His Majesty the King, to convey and alienate the lands described in Schedule (3) to the said Harry Benjafield, in fee simple, or for any less estate or interest in lieu of the said land and in full satisfaction of all claims and demands for compensation.

Commissioner may sell certain land to Helen Coleman. Schedule (4). 6 It shall be lawful for the Commissioner of Crown lands to sell by private contract to *Helen Coleman* the lot of Crown land described in the Schedule (4) hereto for the sum of One Pound; and upon payment of such sum of money into the Treasury, together with a grant fee of Fifteen Shillings, the Governor is hereby authorised, in the name and on behalf of His Majesty the King, to convey and alienate the said land to the said *Helen Coleman*, in fee simple, or for any less estate or interest.
